



NOTICE

Refugees and political asylum seekers who have obtained a form of subsidiary protection in Romania (except UKRAINE) may enroll in studies at the National University of Science and Technology POLITEHNICA Bucharest, during the admission periods established for Romanian citizens, in accordance with the regulations of the faculties, provided that they obtain a Certificate/Attestation of recognition and equivalence of studies completed abroad, issued by the National Center for the Recognition and Equivalence of Diplomas (C.N.R.E.D.). The equivalence is carried out following the C.N.R.E.D. procedures, the same as those provided for citizens coming from European Union member states, the European Economic Area, and the Swiss Confederation.

Starting with the 2026/2027 academic year, the files of candidates who need the CNRED attestation will be submitted exclusively online, through the Electronic Single Point of Contact (PCUe), via the National University of Science and Technology POLITEHNICA Bucharest.

Accordingly, in order to obtain the C.N.R.E.D. attestation, they must submit to the secretariat of the Faculty of Engineering in Foreign Languages (FILS), in accordance with its own schedule, the following documents:

- Study documents obtained abroad (diplomas and transcripts);
- Identity documents certifying status (residence permit);
- Passport (if applicable);
- Birth certificate,
- Marriage certificate (if applicable).

To the extent that other documents are deemed necessary, the University may request additional documents for the file.

Candidates who wish to enroll in the Romanian language preparatory year courses and who fall into the following categories:

- hold a refugee residence permit;
- have subsidiary protection;
- are married to a Romanian citizen (family member with a long-term residence permit of 5/10 years);
- other long-term residence permits;



- citizens of European Union member states;
- citizens of states belonging to the European Economic Area and of the Swiss Confederation;
- British citizens and their family members, as beneficiaries of the Agreement on the withdrawal of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland from the European Union,

must request enrollment directly at the secretariat of the faculty within which the Romanian language preparatory year is organized – the Faculty of Engineering in Foreign Languages, having the CNRED attestation submitted in their file.

The above-mentioned candidates may study the Romanian language preparatory year by paying the fee in lei at the amount established by the university senate for Romanian citizens, or free of charge as applicable (refugees, except UKRAINE).

In order to benefit from the rights arising from the status of a citizen under protection in Romania, for the purpose of subsequent enrollment in the bachelor's, master's, or doctoral studies proper, it is mandatory to pass the admission examination organized on the basis of the university's own admission methodology established for Romanian citizens.
