



LEGISLATION

1. Law No. 122/2006 on asylum in Romania, as subsequently amended and supplemented

- Art. 20 - para. (1), letter h, that “the recognition of refugee status or the granting of subsidiary protection confers upon the beneficiary the following rights: to have access to all forms of education, under the conditions provided by law for Romanian citizens”;

2. Ordinance of the Government of Romania No. 44/2004 on the social integration of foreigners who have obtained a form of protection or a right of residence in Romania, as well as of citizens of the Member States of the European Union, the European Economic Area, and citizens of the Swiss Confederation, as subsequently amended and supplemented,

- Art. 9 - “the access of foreigners who have obtained a form of international protection in Romania to all forms of education is carried out under the conditions established by law for Romanian citizens”.

3. GEO No. 194/2002 on the regime of foreigners in Romania,

- Art. 80 - Equal treatment

(1) Foreigners holding the right of long-term residence benefit, under the conditions of the law, from equal treatment with Romanian citizens with regard to:

b) access to all forms and levels of education and professional training, including the granting of study scholarships;

4. In accordance with: ORDER No. 5516/2024 of 10 July 2024 on the organization and conduct of the Romanian language preparatory year for foreign citizens

Art. 3 (1) The following may participate in the admission to the Romanian language preparatory year program:

a) citizens of the Member States of the European Union, citizens of states belonging to the European Economic Area and of the Swiss Confederation, as well as British citizens and their family members, as beneficiaries of the Agreement on the withdrawal of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland from the European Union;

b) citizens from third states;

c) Romanians from everywhere (Romanians living abroad)
